The Ladies' Favorite.

The newest fashion in ladies' hats will doubtless cause a flutter of pleasurable excitement among the fair sex. Ladies are always susceptible to the changes of a fashion plate; and the more startling the departure, the more earnest the admiration of the manufacturer. This "great American system" that is intended to secure high wages for our laborers is so perverted that all its beneficence intended for the poor workman stops in the pocket of his employer, and the laborer only gets what he can command in the open market for his work.

Let us go on a little further. Here is one yard of flannel, weighing 16 ounces: costs \$1.28; the labor cost is 29 cents; the tariff duty is 80 cents. One pound of sewing silk costs \$5.66; the cost for labor is 85 cents; the tariff is \$1.63. One gallon of linseed oil costs 46 cents; the labor cost is 2 cents; the tariff cost is 25 cents. One ton of bar iron costs \$31; the labor cost is \$10; the tariff fixes several rates for bar iron. One ton of foundry iron costs \$11; the labor costs \$1.61; the tariff is \$6.72.

None of these tariff rates go to the laborer. The road is blocked up. They can not get the pocket of the manufacturer. This "great American system" that is intended to secure high wages for our laborers is so perverted that all its beneficence intended for the poor workman stops in the pocket of his employer, and the laborer only gets what he can command in the open market for his work.
