## FIRST LIEUTENANT DANIEL L. PRICE DIRECTOR, THE SINGING SERGEANTS

Lieutenant Daniel L. Price joined the United States Air Force in August 1995 to become the eleventh director of The Singing Sergeants, the official chorus of the Air Force. During his tenure with the chorus, he has already made appearances before the president and vice president of the United States, the chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the chief of staff of the Air Force.

A native of Muskegon, Michigan, Lieutenant Price resided the 15 years prior to joining the Air Force in the Dayton, Ohio area. He held concurrent positions as music teacher at the Dayton Christian School (the largest independent Christian school in the United States), associate director of music at the Fairhaven Church of Dayton and adjunct professor of voice at Wright State University of Fairborn, Ohio. Currently, he is the music director at Capitol Hill Baptist Church in Washington, D.C.

Lieutenant Price received his bachelor of music education degree from Cedarville College of Cedarville, Ohio (1984), a master of music degree (1991) and a doctorate of musical arts degree (1996) from the College-Conservatory of Music, University of Cincinnati. Among his many collegiate recognitions, Lieutenant Price received both the John E. Kohl Music Award for service and outstanding musicianship, and the Riedvelt Fine Arts Award for service and outstanding performance in the arts.

An outstanding vocalist in his own right, Lieutenant Price sang with the renowned Santa Fe Desert Chorale, the musical experience he credits with being the inspiration to pursue a career in professional choral music. He has also worked with the Dayton Bach Society as guest conductor/lecturer, and was a private voice instructor for eight years. Something of which Lieutenant Price is most proud, he is founder and director of Choralfest, a series of choral concerts which places high school singers along side more seasoned adults to musically challenge and educate young students.
