Plorate filii Israel

Weep, children of Israel, weep all you virgins, and lament the only-begotten daughter of Jepthah in a song of sorrow.

Ye that fear the Lord, wait for his mercy and go not aside from him lest ye fall. Ye that feat the Lord, believe him, and your reward shall not be made void.

Veni Creator Spiritus

Come, Creator Spirit, visit the minds of your people; fill with heavenly grace the hearts that you created.

Festum nunc celebre

The crowded festival and its great joys compel our hearts to give forth songs, when Christ ascends the lofty throne of Heaven, our loving judge.

Erheb den Herren

Raise up the Lord, praise him from the foundation of your heart, now and for all time.

Sing praises to Him, my loving soul, now praise him with heart and voice.

Raise up his worthy name highly, as he did for you on earth, mercifully showered you, preserves you early and late. Praise his wonderful deeds, my loving soul, he has governed you and will not leave you, he will always help you and is your protector.

Lord God, I trust alone in you, let me never be put to shame; save my through your justice from the pains of sin here on earth. Incline your ear to me, help me, a poor prisoner, be my strong Lord and that which is most beautiful to me, and do not allow me to stray from the path, pity my weakness

Ihr lieben Christen, freut euch nun

You beloved Christians, be happy now, soon will appear God's Son, he who our brother is become, it is the Lord Jesus Christ.

Rejoice for this birth. God be praised. Blessed be God.

Praised be the holy Trinity, God be praised in everything, Hallelujah.

I will not depart from God, and he will not depart from me, he leads me through all paths, otherwise I would err, he extends to me his hand from evening until morning, he keeps me well supplied wherever I go.

It is only right that one as poor as I should praise you and remain your subject,

my acknowledged head and highest ruler.

Arisen is the holy Christ, the consolation of the whole world. And if He had not arisen the whole world would pass away. Because He has arisen, we praise the Lord Jesus Christ. Three holy women went early in the morning through the dew. [The angels said] "He is without, He is not here." Have thanks, you beloved fine angels, now all will be joyful. "Go forth," he said to Saint Peter, "and sing praises with the disciples." Now sing all at this time, arisen is the holy Christ.
